- Program core is 130 hours of direct clinical supervision with highly experienced faculty
- Graduate credits towards postprofessional doctoral degrees

Application Process

- There is a formal application process and intake periods are flexible (rolling).
- Previously obtained didactic and clinical hours in related sciences, orthopaedic and manual therapy PT may be eligible for transfer into the program.
- Acceptance is dependent on student qualifications, their learning plan and availability of faculty.

Individualized Time-Line

Clinical Fellowship Instructor (CFI) and Student design an individual time plan to progress through the curriculum, examinations, clinical hours and fellowship project within the thirty-six month period, or less. The part-time program is designed to minimize travel and time away from home and work.

Student Responsibility

- Student needs to be self-motivated and takes responsibility for the pacing and scheduling of classes, examinations and clinical weeks.
- Student will have the multiple resources available on-line, by telephone and in person.

Locations:

NAIOMT does not have one central clinical site, it has multiple sites which may be at the clinical instructor's employment site, the instructor may travel to the student's site or they may meet for a clinical education week at an independent site. Classroom hours are at the "weekend" courses at NAIOMT's various teaching sites.
